

PE and Sports Premium, Governor Report – 2024/25

The PE and Sports Premium is a grant provided to primary schools by the government. The money received is ringfenced and must be used to enhance the opportunities for all pupils to experience healthy and active lives. Embedding this ethos early will lead to the long-term health benefits of the nation. Physical activity has numerous benefits for children's physical health and mental wellbeing, leading to happier and more resilient individuals.

2024/25 Funding

The total grant awarded for 2024/25: £17,640

Spending

The school has been able to use the money to develop staff CPD and still be involved in a wide range of activities. The school has also used the money to take part in trips and events.

MPS have been able to utilize the sports premium. Key areas of spending this year include:

- Membership to the West Norwich and Dereham School Sports Partnership (WNDSSP): £3050

This membership provides a number of benefits to the school including mentoring and guidance to Mr Stains and Mr Consterdine as the PE and Sports lead, advice and guidance on getting the best from sports premium, assistance with obtaining and analysing data from pupil surveys, provision of sports and physical activity sessions for all pupils, inter-schools competitions and events, and transport co-ordination for these.

- PE Resources - £535

To ensure all staff teaching PE are confidently delivery high quality learning to all pupils. MMD, GS RS trained to use Real PE. Staff CPD around review methods used in RealPE. Staff have been using Create Development's Learning Nutrition to identify their next steps in their own teaching of PE. The Learning Nutrition's matrix has been used to assess and self-assess progress.

- New Sound System - £350

To provide all years with a high quality dance experience using new sound system. Also to be used for Sports day and other sporting events. All children to benefit in dance and gym lessons with new sound system providing better quality music to perform to.

- Create Development membership: £695

Buy into RealPE, Real GYM, Real DANCE, and RealPE at home – these resources are used in over half the school schools PE lessons. All children in the school using Create Development scheme of work in at least half of their PE lessons ensuring high quality PE.

- PPA Cover - Lessons Taught by Mr Staines - £10,000

To provide all classes with a high quality PE lesson taught by an experienced coach and teacher of PE

- Swimming top-Up: £1,540

Swimming aged at year 3- 6 and targeted student who have not had access to swimming and not currently possible to meet the recommended standard required by the end of year 6. 85 % of children have left Year 6 having met the NC standard for swimming.

Current spend - £16,170

Remaining - £1,440

Impact of PE&SP funding from previous years

The Real PE programme of structured lessons and resources have been vital in providing a quality curriculum. Real PE has a number of additional modules that the school has invested in including Real Gym and Real Dance. One of the challenges of providing consistent high quality PE lessons can be teacher confidence, teacher get a lot of support and opportunities to take part in events and CPD if required. P

WNDSSP provides a diverse range of inter school activities which if left to individual schools to organise would take an inordinate amount of teaching time to arrange and co-ordinate. As noted above the partnership provides a host of other supportive functions. The involvement in these activities has decreased in the past year due to the increase in travel expense, also there are fewer free teaching hours (LTA support) in the school and cover cost increasing therefore taking students out on sporting trips is not financial possible. The school has been able to deliver some after school sporting events thanks to funding from different avenues.

A large percentage of the SSP money has been spent on Mr Staines wages which allows high quality PE to be delivered and allowing all pupils to receive this across the school.

Review of targets set at the start of 2023/24 Sports Premium

Targets for 2022/23 - will be confirmed in the Autumn term

- Ensure long term sustainability of teaching P.E (**ongoing**)
- Swimming top up to target specific children (**ongoing**)
- Playground/ Hall development to continue with the help of Synergy. (**Ongoing**)
- To upgrade gymnastics floor mats and any other resources that require a top up

Targets for 2025/26

- To sustain high level PE delivery.
- To continue to the part in as many WNDSSP events to make sure the membership is worthwhile.
- Ensure resources in the school are maintain and kept to a high standard
- Swimming top up to target specific children
- Playground/ Hall development to continue with the help of Synergy.
